Project Funding/Cost – Sharing/Incentives:

Landowner

- 1. Will pay 30% of invoiced cost for backhoe and dozer (if required) for works completed.
- 2. Will prepare berm area with proper seedbed for seeding forage and seed area down as soon as soil conditions allow.
- 3. Seed will be supplied at no charge by the District.
- 4. Will make every reasonable attempt to control nuisance beaver from altering or damaging waterway.

Conservation District

- 1. Ensure all required permits and agreements are in place prior to project start.
- 2. Contribute all additional costs excluding the costs supplied by landowner.
- 3. Complete all required survey and engineering works.
- 4. Provide contractor, equipment and materials for project for District portion.
- 5. Supervise contractor as required.
- 6. Ensure proper and sufficient permanent forage establishment and complete any maintenance required for 2 years following construction.
- 7. District is not responsible for any alterations or damage caused by beaver activity.

The Landowner Shall:

Allow consent of entry onto property for purposes of the project;

- Provide access for inspection, evaluation, or further construction of the project by the Conservation District at any reasonable or future time;
- Not alter, change, remove or modify the project without written consent of the District;
- Ensure agricultural use and practices do not alter or effect the integrity of the project by ensuring that permanent forage in drain and buffer remain.
- Allow district to place signage at the project site for CD contribution to project; signage removal must be approved by Conservation District prior to removal;
- Indemnify and save harmless the District from any and all actions, claims, suits, damages, injuries, or other loss no matter howsoever arising as a result of the construction, operation or maintenance of the project, and;
- Grant the conservation district the right to use any information related to this project for educational or promotional purposes.
- Agree to cost sharing as per Appendix 1

The Conservation District Shall:

• Reserve the right to reasonable access to project areas for tours, educational purposes or to inspect the condition of the project site at any time following completion of the project.
